**WHY DID I GET THIS NOTICE?** A settlement (“Settlement”) has been reached in a class action lawsuit concerning alleged disruptions to the online stream of the August 26, 2017 Pay-Per-View boxing matches featuring Floyd Mayweather vs. Conor McGregor (the “Event”). According to available records, you might be a Settlement Class Member. The purpose of this notice is to inform you of the Settlement so that you may learn what rights you have so you can decide what your options are and steps to take in relation to those options.

This email notice is only a summary of your legal rights and obligations under the Settlement. **WHAT IS THIS LAWSUIT ABOUT?** The lawsuit was filed against Zuffa, LLC and NeuLion, Inc. (collectively, “Defendants”) by select purchasers of the Event alleging Defendants’ system suffered from a defect preventing purchasers of the Event from being able to view some or all the Event. In their Complaint, Plaintiffs have asserted certain claims, including those for breach of contract and for violation of applicable consumer protection laws, and sought refunds, damages and other relief from Defendants. Defendants deny each of the allegations of unlawful conduct, any wrongdoing, and any liability whatsoever, and no court or other entity has made any judgment or other determination of liability. The class action lawsuit is pending in the U.S. District Court for the District of Nevada titled *Park, et al. v. Zuffa, LLC, d/b/a Ultimate Fighting Championship and UFC, et al.*, Case No. 17-cv-02282-APG-VCF (D. Nev.) (the “Action”). This Settlement represents a compromise by the Parties to highly disputed legal and factual issues.

**AM I A CLASS MEMBER?** You are a “Settlement Class Member” if you are a person who, from a United States address, purchased access to stream the Event for viewing as a consumer on UFC.TV, the UFC mobile application, Amazon Fire TV, Apple TV, Microsoft Xbox, Roku, or on LG or Samsung devices. If you are receiving this notice, you are most likely a Settlement Class Member, but should confirm by checking your purchase records.

**WHAT DO I GET FROM THE SETTLEMENT?** If you are a “Settlement Class Member,” and were not able to view some or all of the Event due to streaming disruption, you are eligible to receive a one-time cash payment in an amount ranging from \$25 up to \$99.99 depending on how much of the Event you were unable to watch because of such disruption. You are advised that Defendants will be comparing claims with their internal access logs, to verify Settlement Class Members’ viewing history of the Event. ***Additionally, if you incurred out of pocket expenses for items such as food and beverages purchased to enjoy while watching the Event, you may receive*** one to three months of free access to UFC Fight Pass or \$5.00 in cash for reimbursement of expenses (*i.e.*, food and drink purchased for the Event) depending on the amount expended. Those Settlement Class Members making a claim for three months of free access to UFC Fight Pass or \$5.00 will need to provide proof of their expenses. **To receive a Settlement payment, you must properly and timely complete and submit a Claim Form**, which explains the eligibility and any documentation requirements for the different payment categories. A Claim Form is available on the internet at the Settlement website [www.UFCPPVSettlement.com](http://www.UFCPPVSettlement.com). The deadline to submit a Claim Form is August 20, 2018. On the Claim Form you will need to select and submit for only one of the following categories:



**WHAT ARE MY OPTIONS?**

- 1. File a Claim by August 20, 2018 and Remain in the Settlement Class.** If you wish to receive payment and/or other settlement benefits you must submit a Claim Form by **August 20, 2018**. Claim Forms received after that date will be considered late and will not be accepted.
- 2. Do Nothing and Remain in the Settlement Class.** If you do nothing you will not receive any benefits but will be bound by the decisions of the Court regarding these claims, including the release of liability for certain claims against Defendants.
- 3. Enter an Appearance Through Your Own Counsel and Remain in the Settlement Class.** Although you do not need to do so, you may enter an appearance through an attorney of your own choice, at your own expense.

**4. Exclude yourself from the Settlement Class.** If you do not want to be legally bound by the Settlement, you must exclude yourself from the Settlement by the Opt-Out deadline of **June 8, 2018**, or you won't be able to sue Defendants about the legal claims in the Action ever again. If you exclude yourself, you cannot receive a Settlement Payment or other benefits from this Settlement, but will not be subject to the Release. **5. Object to Terms of the Settlement and Remain in the Settlement Class.** You may write to the Court and say why you do not like the Settlement and object to its terms. The deadline to file objections is **June 8, 2018**. **YOU'RE INVITED TO A FAIRNESS HEARING.** The Court will hold a hearing on **July 20, 2018 at 9:00 a.m.** in Courtroom 6C of the United States District Court located at 333 Las Vegas Blvd. S., Las Vegas, NV 89101 to consider: (1) whether to approve the Settlement as fair, adequate and reasonable to the Settlement Class; (2) whether any objections filed, if any, have merit; (3) the requests by the lawyers representing all Class Members for a Fee and Expense Award, and the request by the Class Representatives for Class Representative Service Awards. The hearing may be moved to a different date or time without additional notice, so it is a good idea to check [www.UFCPPVSettlement.com](http://www.UFCPPVSettlement.com) for updates. The motion for Fee and Expense Awards will be posted on the Settlement Website after they are filed and at least ten days before the Objection Deadline. You or your own lawyer, if you have one, may ask to appear and speak at the hearing at your own cost, but you don't have to.
